4 to 1 Safety Factor

All CRP Thermoplastic Hose has 4 to 1 safety factor when it comes to burst pressure. For example, if a hose is rated at a 10,000 psi dynamic working pressure, it has a tested burst pressure of 40,000 psi or greater.

"Very few hose suppliers are willing to stand behind this safety factor and guarantee it in writing. We have never experienced a problem with the CRP products deteriorating during a rescue." says Ed Lyons.

Maintains Consistent Pressure in Extreme Situations

In an operation where speed and efficiency are essential to savings lives, it is absolutely critical that a constant and even rate of working hydraulic pressure is pumped to the hydraulic cutting tools. The hoses supplying this pressure are truly life-lines.

Reports Ed Lyons "Our rescue team customers that use CRP Industrial Hose have never experienced kinking or crimping of the hose that would lead to a temporary loss of working hydraulic pressure."

Welded Twin Lines

CRP Industrial does not use tape or clamps to hold twin lines together — the lines are welded together as part of the manufacturing process. This is critical, according to Lyons, "The rescue team operator is able to firmly secure the hose during the operation without the need to exert additional energy to keep the twin lines together — which can occur when taped or clamped lines fail."

Fittings that fit better

"In addition to the burst pressure safety factor, our customers also comment on the range of fittings offered by CRP and the manner in which they are affixed to the hose." offers Ed Lyons. It's for reasons like this that customers often ask him for CRP brand hose by name.
